<u>Tech Corner</u>

How to Post on Facebook

Website users can change their own online profile data (note, this is not the official NFP roster data). All other website changes must be made by the Webmaster.



would become a full-time job if it all had to be done by a single individual. This is the reason we have a (private) **Facebook NFP Group page** (<u>LINK</u>) where individual members can publish their own updates, comments, posts, and photos.

Five types of Facebook Activities.

- Look / Read Simply peruse the "Feed" (column of articles) and see what the NFP is up to.
- "Like" / React Click the "Thumbs-Up" icon button to "Like" (show agreement or appreciation) a post or comment. Hover over this icon and other reactions will pop up including "Love", "Care", "Ha-ha", "Wow", "Sad", and "Angry".
- 3. "Comment" If you have something to say about someone else's post. You can add a "Comment" to it or "Reply" to someone else's comment.
 - a. Comments can be edited or deleted. Click and hold the comment until possible actions pop up. Select the desired action.
- 4. "Post" Create your own post. First, find the blank space near the top of the feed (below the group photo) labeled, "Write something..." (PC) or, "What's on your mind? (iPhone). Click in this box and start typing. Click "Enter" to submit the post.
 - a. Posts can be edited or deleted by clicking the triple-dot icon at the upper right corner of the post and selecting the desired action.
- "Post Photos" one or many photos can be posted or included in a post. There are two basic ways to do this – "Pull" or "Push".
 - a. Pull from phone into Facebook:
 - i. Start on the Facebook NFP Group page.
 - ii. Start a post (click on "Write something...") and click the "Add Photo/video" icon ().
 - iii. Select all the photos you want to "share" (post) by swiping and clicking the circle in each photos' corner.,
 - iv. Click, "Done".
 - v. Add a message if desired.

- vi. Select "Post".
- b. Push Push from Photo Viewer (iPhone):
 - i. On your smart phone, open your photo viewer and find the first photo to post.
 - ii. Click the "Share" icon (1).
 - iii. Select all the photos you want to "share" (post) by swiping and checking the circle in each photos' corner.
 - iv. Below the row of photos, find and select the Facebook icon (to share on Facebook).
 - v. Select "Groups" & the NFP group.
 - vi. Add a message if desired.
 - vii. Select "Post".

A single photo can be posted in a comment using the camera icon while commenting

Facebook Usage / Tips:

- A good YouTube video primer on Facebook for beginners is <u>HERE</u>. Others can be found with simple searches on, for example, Google.
- 2. Search for (and join) our group by clicking on the "search" tool (magnifying glass) and searching for "*Highlands Nifty Fifties...Plus*".
- 3. Once a Facebook NFP group member, quickly find our group on your mobile device by clicking on the Facebook "Menu" (triple bars lower left corner) and clicking "Groups".
 - a. Alternatively, click on the "search" tool (magnifying glass). This pulls up "recent searches".
- 4. When using your PC to make a post or comment, create a "line-break" (a "return" without entering/submitting the post or comment) by using "shift-enter". This works in most applications
